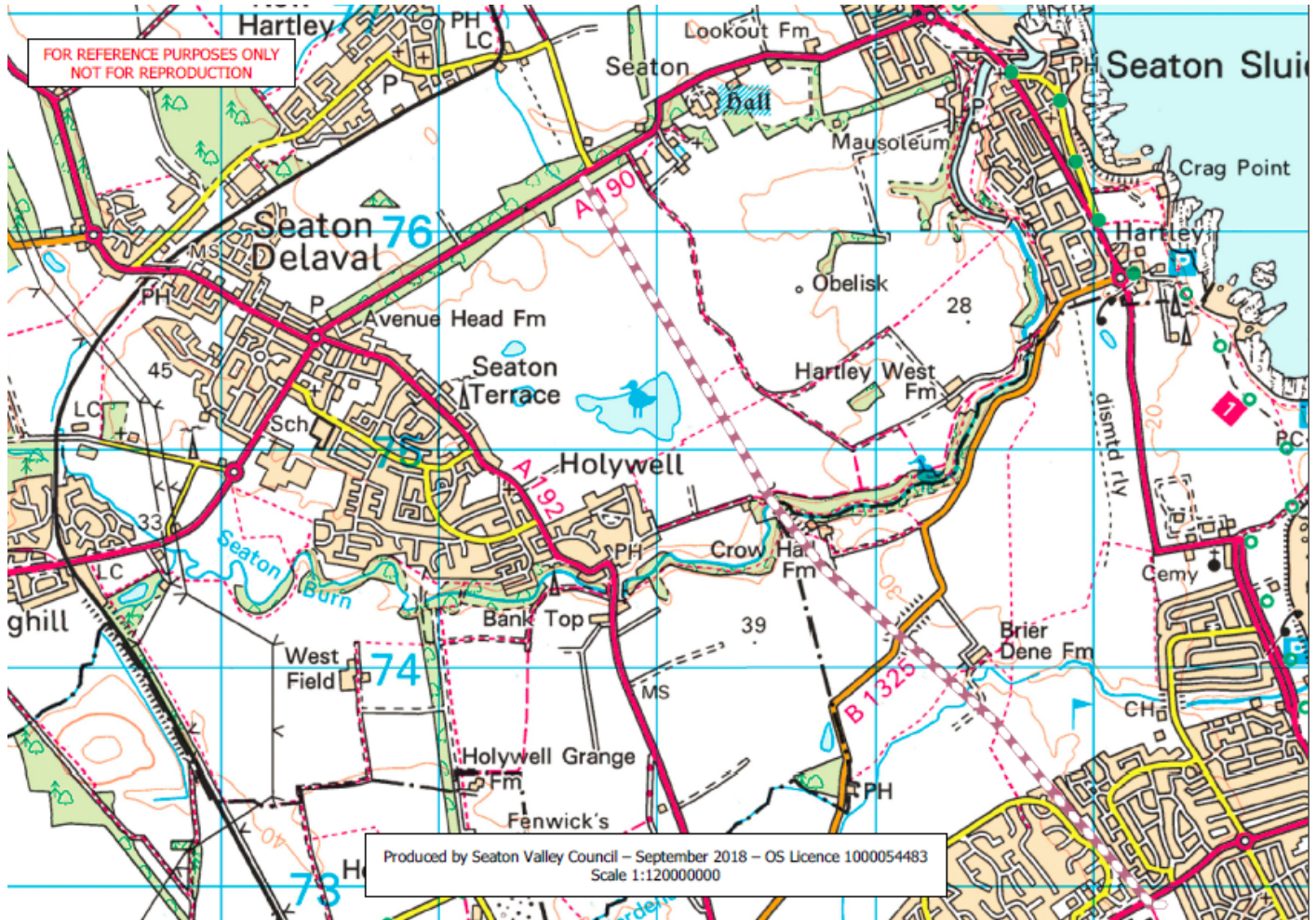


**The Waggonway** runs from The Avenue to Whitley Bay. Once part of the network of railway lines used to transport coal, this traffic free route is a popular way to cut through Seaton Valley.

The path passes beside Holywell ponds to the west and Seaton Delaval Hall Obelisk to the East, through the trees to Holywell Dene. At the old bridge you can decide to head east to Seaton Sluice, west to Holywell village for refreshment, or carry on south to Whitley Bay. Details of the Holywell to Seaton Sluice Cycle Path can be found on a separate route map.

If you choose to stay on The Waggonway the path eventually ends in Whitley Bay or you can leave it at the A1148 and cycle east, on the road, down to the sea and the Links and Promenade at Whitley Bay seafront.
