Terms and Conditions

1. All categories are open to all residents, businesses and community groups of Seaton Valley. To enter, please complete an application form and return it to us.
2. If you are not sure which category your application would fall into, please contact Lorraine Fox for advice.
3. You can nominate another person's work.
4. Judges will be the Seaton Valley Services Officer, a Parish Councillor and a member of Northumberland County Council's Neat team.
5. A list of winners will be available on the website after the Awards Presentation on 4 September 2019.
6. All entries must be received by the 12 July 2019. Any entries received after this date will not be entered into the competition.
7. Please ensure you have provided a postal address and contact details on the entry form.
8. No plastic or artificial flowers are allowed in any categories other than the 'Best Mini Garden Aged 3-12' and 'Best School Display'.
9. The judges' decision will be final.
10. Judges reserve the right to disqualify entrants if they consider that the entrant has breached any of these terms and conditions.
11. No photographs are needed with your application as photographs will be taken during the judging period; however you can if you wish to send us photographs of your displays at their best.
12. By entering the competition you agree that you will allow the judges to view and photograph your entry.
13. The personal data supplied on this application form will only be used by Seaton Valley Council for the purpose of our Gardening Competition. The data will not be shared or published without your permission.
